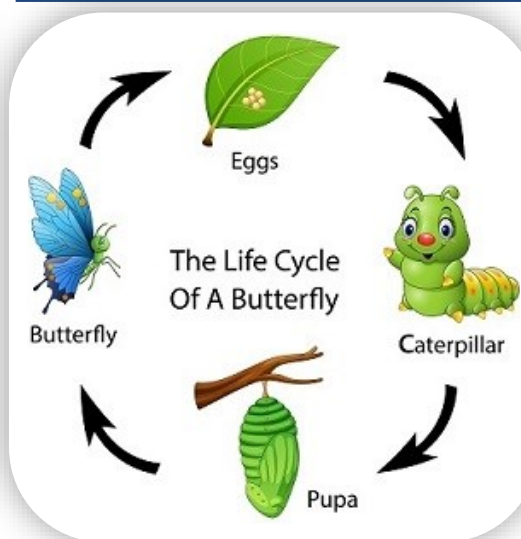
Before and After School Care
