Update: Spring 2021 Literacy Data

Our Spring reading data shows that almost all students in grades 1-3 have made gains, many of them significant gains, in reading this year. We believe that the continuity of instruction and supportive interventions have contributed to these gains. In grade 1, 80% of students are meeting or exceeding expectations in reading. For grades 2 and 3, when we remove *tier 3 learner data* for students with significant learning/behaviour challenges, 35% (grade 2) and 85% (grade 3) of students are meeting or exceeding expectations in reading.
