It's that time of year again, and we have had a few reported cases.



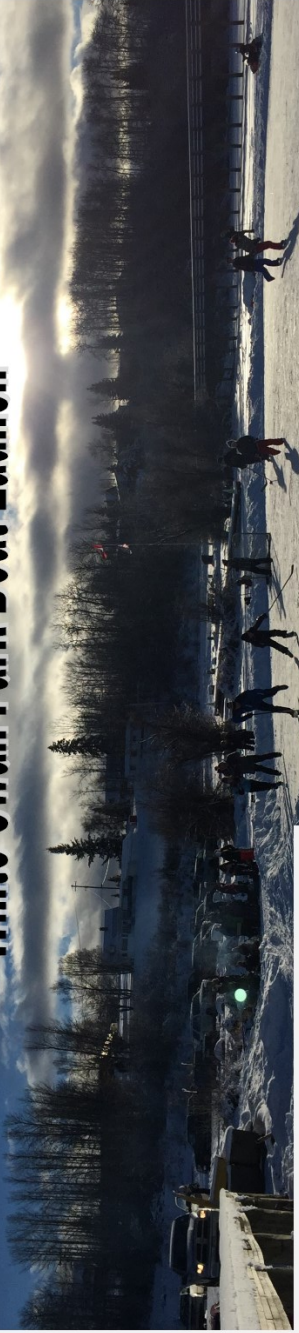

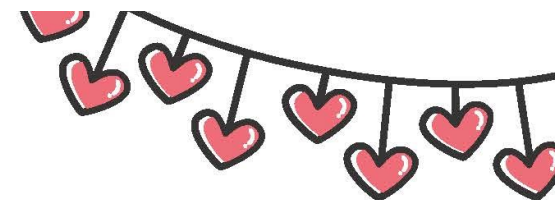
