(STOP NOW AND PLAN)



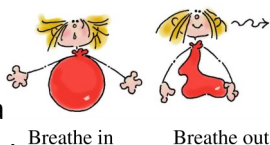
Even though it is warming up, there is plenty of cold weather to keep us cooped up inside.

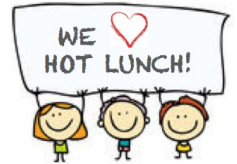
