Superintendent Karla Mitchell presented her monthly report at the Regular School Board Meeting on May 15, 2023.

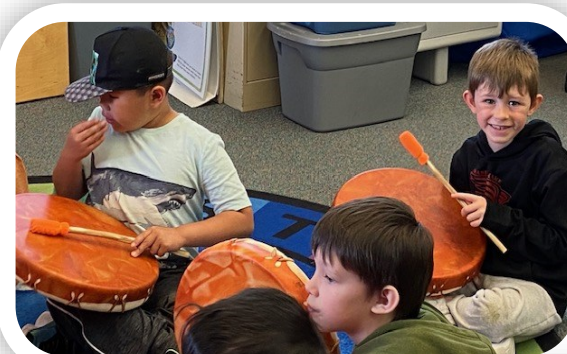
