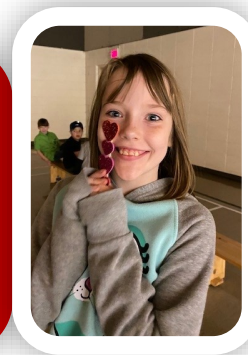

The School District 91 Policy Committee is currently working on updates to Policy 904.2 – Use of Facilities by Outside Organizations.

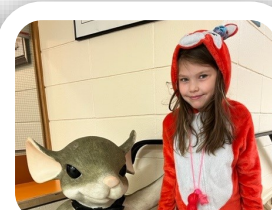

Join us for an assembly at 9:45 am. We will wear pink on this day to show the world that everyone deserves to be treated with kindness and respect.

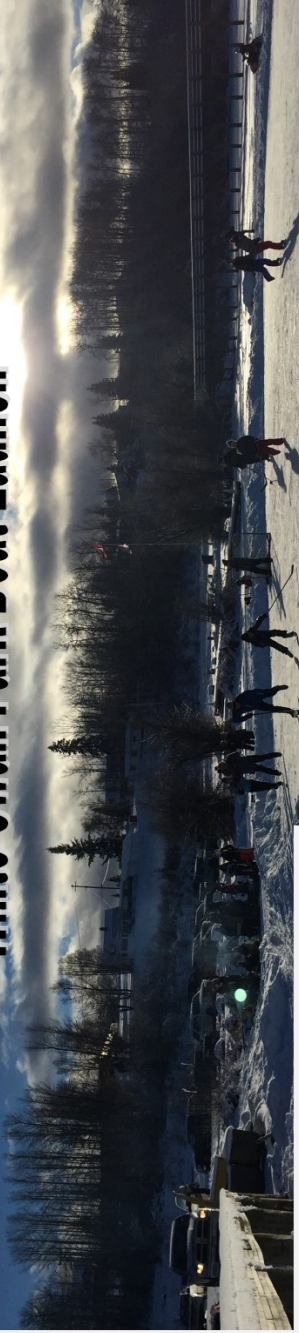
