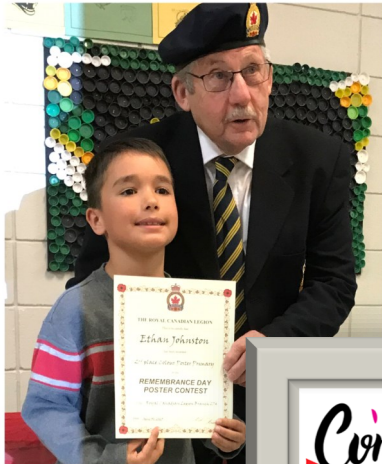
Jump Day is May 19th! Come and join us at 1:00 pm. Our fundraising goal is \$2000!
