Re: Update on Masks for K-3 Students

Dear parents and guardians,

As announced this morning by Education Minister, Jennifer Whiteside, and our Provincial Health Officer, Dr. Bonnie Henry, the K-12 health and safety guidelines have been updated to **require masks for Kindergarten to grade 3 students** in addition to the existing guidelines requiring masks for our grade 4 to 12 students. The expanded mask mandate begins Monday, Oct. 4<sup>th</sup>. Students will wear a mask on the bus as well as when indoors, except when eating. Students do not need to wear a mask when outdoors.

Although we will have masks available for our K-3 students if needed, we encourage our families to send their children to school with a preferred mask and to have a conversation with their child about the importance of wearing a mask. Families can practice putting on a mask properly (instructions from the BCCDC are attached).

I would encourage you to send a ziplock bag with your child to keep the mask clean when not in use (such as during snack or lunch time). We will provide your child with a clean disposable children's mask if their mask is dirty or misplaced.

Please know that all staff in the school are here to support your child and help them in a positive, caring way to follow these new guidelines.



## **How to Wear a Face Mask**



Wash your hands with soap and water for 20-30 seconds or perform hand hygiene with alcohol-based hand rub before touching the face mask.



Check the new mask to make sure it's not damaged.



Ensure colour side of the mask faces outwards.



Locate the metallic strip. Place it over and mold it to the nose bridge.



Place an ear loop around each ear or tie the top and bottom straps.



Cover mouth and nose fully, making sure there are no gaps. Pull the bottom of the mask to fully open and fit under your chin.



Press the metallic strip again to fit the shape of the nose. Perform hand hygiene.



Do not touch the mask while using it, if you do, perform hand hygiene.



Replace the mask if it gets wet or dirty and wash your hands again after putting it on. Do not reuse the mask.

## **Removing the Mask**



Perform hand hygiene.



Do not touch the front of your mask. Lean forward, gently remove the mask from behind by holding both ear loops or ties.



Discard the mask in a waste container.



Perform hand hygiene.
