

Government of British Columbia will deposit a \$1,200 BC Training and Education Savings Grant into the RESP for your child. Students can use the money to pay for their education expenses (e.g., tuition, books, tools, rent, or transportation) in an apprenticeship program, Once you open an account, known as a Registered Education Savings Plan (RESP), the trade school, CEGEP, college, or university. Plan today: you don't have to put any money into the RESP for your child to receive the \$1,200. Step 1: Get Social Insurance Numbers (SINs) for you and your child. Go to the Service Canada SIN Overview webpage or call 1-800-622-6232 to find out how. Step 2: Make an appointment with a financial organization that offers RESPs. Bring the SINs for you and your child and let them know that you want to open an RESP and get the B.C. Training Education Savings grant for your child.
