Dear Mouse Mountain Families,

The announcement of school opening for face-to-face learning is likely causing some concern and even excitement for our little ones. This part-time attendance at school is entirely voluntary and whatever your decision is we respect your choice. We will continue to support you and your children if you choose to keep them home. If you choose to send your children to school, we will implement all the measures recommended by Public Health which include, frequent cleaning, physical distancing, small groups, frequent handwashing, and very clear expectations that no one is at school if they have any

symptoms of illness. Our district staff are in regular contact with the Ministry of Health and we will respond quickly to any changes. Our plan is to be outside learning as much as possible. We plan to stagger outside schedules so only small groups children are in the playground at a time. Children will wash their hands before going outside and immediately after coming back in.

If you send your child to school, please remind them to demonstrate caring through non-contact. Practice handwashing following Public Health guidelines. Wash for 20 seconds and use paper towel to turn off taps.
