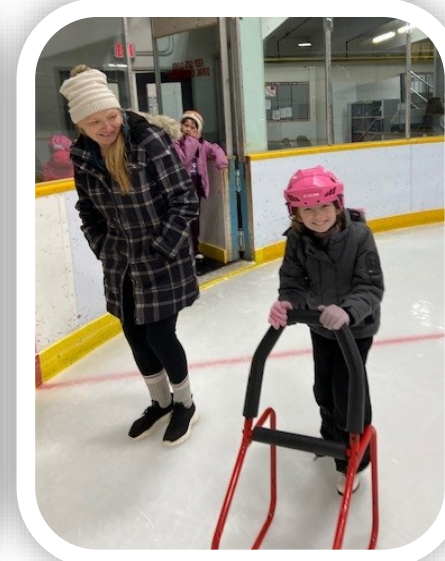
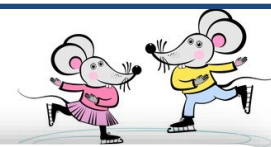


Before and After School Care

FAMILY DISCOUNT- 10% off to families with 2+ children registered in the 23/24 FLMHA season.

EARLY REGISTRATION RATES- Applicable to fees paid in full by June 30, 2023.

PAYMENT- Payment plan available through team snap.

CHILDREN UNDER 5- Must have 1 parent on ice. Parent must pay \$50 insurance fee, have criminal record check, respect in sport and CATT course completed through Hockey Canada.

REFUND POLICY- 100% reimbursement for registration fee before first practice. 80% reimbursement before November 1, 2023. 60% reimbursement before December 1, 2023. No refund after December 1, 2023.

EARLY BIRD DRAW- Each child's name who is registered on or before April 11, 2023, will be entered into a draw. Can complete payment online through team snap, cash, or cheque. Prizes include 100%, 50%, and 25% off child's registration fee. The three draws will take place at the AGM on April 11, 2023. Winners must be in attendance to claim prize.

EXECUTIVE POSITIONS- Individuals filling the FLMHA President, Treasurer, and Registrar positions will receive free registration for one child. If the individual has multiple children registered to the FLMHA, free registration will apply to the lowest registration fee.
